However, Alberto stopped by today to talk for a few minutes, filled with wonder. He's the one whose three-bladed folding propeller I treated with PropPurr a year or so ago. His sailboat, *Sin Fronteras*, has been in the water for about 13 months now, and sitting quietly at Alberto's dock for more than half that.

Snowbird Alberto arrived back in Vero last week. One of the first things he did was hire a diver to scrub the bottom of his boat and clean the prop so he could motor down to Fort Pierce for haul out when ready. When the diver was finished, he came up and told Alberto there was no growth on the propeller, but plenty on the hull. The antifouling on the hull was Micron 66. The propeller was coated with PropPurr™ and nothing else. You should be encouraged. I'll see to it that Alberto's prop gets a coat of PropPurr™ when he hauls out, a couple of weeks from now.
